The success of Facilities Management in providing the services outlined on the following pages depends on a strong communications network within the university community. To strengthen this network, each department is encouraged to appoint an individual to represent its respective area.

Operations supervisors and managers are responsible for the delivery of Facilities' services to the campus and are the primary liaisons, who provide for and often expedite the delivery of these services to the university community. These supervisors are the main contact between the appointed departmental coordinator/liaison and Facilities Management. They also identify, report, and follow up on building problems by conducting tours in buildings for quality control and by defining conditions that require remedial action. Managers and supervisors can also help you when a service request or maintenance item is not being addressed in a timely manner or when it has a high priority.
